

## PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

As we move into the final months of our program, we are excited to get outside more and enjoy the sunshine! Our goal is 60 minutes a day during Spring/Fall and our children enjoy it immensely. They love to run in the field, climb up the big rocks, slide down the biggest slide and explore in the woods.

Our curriculum allows the children to explore creatively in areas of art, language, social aspects, science and play.

Our preschool follows the Nova Scotia Early Learning Curriculum Framework which ensures we have an emergent and play based curriculum. A third of our mornings are spent outside exploring gross motor opportunities in our neighborhood, going on hikes, exploring nearby playgrounds and looking for worms!

During our activities we have the opportunity to use many loose parts. Things such as buttons, twigs or old jars become brand new toys for our preschoolers.


Over the next few weeks we will be winding up our program, prepping for our year end celebration and spending lot of time outside.

## STATUS OF LICENSE

We recently had our bi-annual inspection from the Dept. of Education and our license has been renewed. Our next inspection will be in the Fall.

## SMART GOAL

Our new smart goal for 2025 is to integrate activities from different represented cultures with our centre into our Preschool and After School Programs.



## PRESCHOOL PORTFOLIOS

Portfolios go home three times a year following the Fall, Winter & Spring terms. These portfolio's are not like the year end artwork portfolios but instead they are a visual into your child's time at our centre. It shows their growth, learning and understanding in ways you wouldn't necessarily see at home.

These portfolios explore the 4 main Learning Goals (*Well-Being, Language & Communication, Personal & Social and Discovery & Invention*) for preschool aged children.

## PRESCHOOL ENROLLMENT

Registration for our Sept 2025 Preschool Program is currently ongoing but space is limited as we have several children returning. We will be offering a full-time morning program for children age 2.5 years to school aged.

### PUBLIC HEALTH

For the safety of all staff and children, we kindly ask that children remain home if they are sick. Children who have a fever, vomiting or diarrhea must be symptom free for a minimum of 24 hours after that last time they exhibited these symptoms, without the requirement of medication.

### MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT

We continue to use loose parts in our centre each day, adding new items whenever possible! We've recently purchased some new books, art supplies and games.

### AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM PD DAYS

In September we will continue to offer a PD Day Program for our After School Program beginning at 12pm, following our morning preschool program. This will also include an afternoon snack.

### AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM ABSENCE DAYS & PICK UP

Please notify both Joy & Garlanda via text by 2:15pm on days your child will be absent from the After School Program. This allows us sufficient time to see your text before 2:35pm dismissal and not leave us waiting for a child who isn't attending that day.

If there is a day when you are running late, feel free to text Joy & Garlanda 10-15 mins ahead of time asking them to have your child ready to go upon arrival. We don't mind helping if it helps the progress go smoother/faster for you!

### TRAINING

In April, Joy and Garlanda completed another workshop under the Capable, Confident & Curious: Module 4 connecting Learning Goals, Learning Objectives and Strategies Framework. This is one of the first offered under the 2025 Capable, Confident & Curious Curriculum Framework and accompanying Educator's Guide.

In May, they also completed the "Signing Together" workshop hosted by NSCC which was a 1.5hr session teaching sign language.
